

2021 Accomplishments

Historic New Richmond, Inc. and RNRI Preservation Grant

- Grant goal: repairs or updates to Village of New Richmond historic buildings (private residences).
- Three grants awarded.
- Stone wall rebuild, painting, wood siding repairs, and front porch ornamental block replacement.

RiverArts Festival Gift

- The festival showcases local talent that includes music, painting, photography, crafts, and sculptures.
- RNRI's donation to the RiverArts festival supported festival operations and advertising.

Riverfront Summer Concert Series

- Raised over \$3000 in donations to support the "Wind Down Wednesday Summer Concert Series".
- Organized and hosted fifteen concerts at Haussermann Park and the Village band stand.
- Helped generate revenue for businesses along Front Street on a historically "slow" business day.

- Repurposed 2 acres of vacant FEMA mitigated properties. Valued @ \$113,000.
- Awarded a major grant of \$20,000.00 from the Nestle Purina PetCare company.

Village Band Stand Repairs

 Received private donations to support repair work and painting of the band stand, a Village of New Richmond focal point for festivals and concerts.

OEPA EV Charging Station Grant

 Worked with the Village of New Richmond Administrator to apply for an electric vehicle charging grant hosted by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency.
